- 3. Only blue ribbon winners are eligible for rosettes and trophies.
- 4. Each Bird Can Be Shown Only Once.
- 5. "Pen" birds CANNOT be shown as singles or any other class.
- 6. All cages must be drip-proof OR set on the mulch inside the show ring.
- 7. Waterfowl (ducks and geese) must remain caged in an area AT LEAST two (2) feet away from other poultry.
- 8. Show chair reserves the right to subdivide classes, if necessary.
