- 2. Ham and Bacon judging to begin at 2 p.m.
- 3. Only the top 15 bacon receiving blue ribbons may sell at the auction.
- 4. All bacon entries will need to be picked up by 6 p.m. on Tuesday, July 19th.
- 5. Participants may sell 1 ham and 1 bacon (per maximum 2 item guidelines for Randolph County Blue Ribbon Auction.
- 6. Member must be present at the sale unless pre-approved by Fair Board and Bacon Chairpersons.
- 7. No bacon receiving a red or white ribbon will sell.

Notices

- Exhibitors selling bacon in the auction, are required to get their picture taken with their bacon. Exhibitors must wear their fair shirt for all photos. Photos will be taken on July 19th at 6 p.m.
- Exhibitors are responsible for getting the bacon sliced and packaged to sell in the Randolph County Blue Ribbon Auction. The auction is on Friday July 22 at 7 p.m.
- The judge has the right to disqualify any and all hams and/or bacons for spoilage, worms, mouse holes, etc.
- If a buyer has a problem with a bacon or ham, they are to contact the Livestock Superintendent within two (2) weeks after the sale and return the product. If the product is considered to be bac, the exhibitor is responsible for refunding the money to the buyer.
- Only federally inspected and pack products may be shown or sold.
- The judge's decisions are final.
